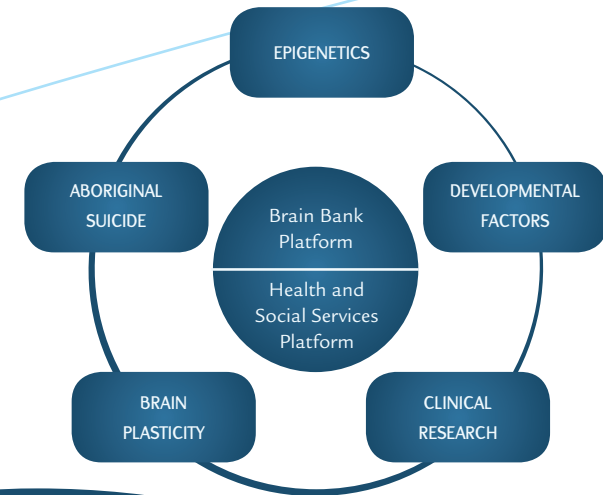
The Réseau is open to all researchers, clinicians, health care professionals and mental health workers working in suicide research and prevention in Quebec.
